## Cooperation with the

**Professional Community (CPC)** - carry the message to professionals

who work with alcoholics.
Public Information (PI) - help carry the message by working with the media.

• **District Committee Member** (DCM) - represent the groups of the district at area committee meetings and coordinate service activities for the district.

• Secretary - keep mailing lists and rosters up- to-date, record meeting minutes and distribute district mailings.

• **Treatment Facilities** - coordinate the work of individual A.A. members and groups who carry the message to alcoholics in treatment facilities.

• **Treasurer** - keep financial records for the district and report regularly to the assembly.

**Corrections**- carry the message to inmate alcoholics inside correctional institutions and upon release.

• Grapevine Representative (GVR) -make members aware of the Fellowship's international journal and the enhancements to sobriety it offers.

Group Service

**Representative (GSR)** - transmit ideas and opinions of your group to district meetings , area assemblies and the General Service Conference.

 Answering Service coordinate the rotation and responsiveness of volunteers managing inbound calls to the answering service.

• **Special Needs**- carry the A.A. message of recovery to alcoholics with disabilities.
