I learned that the meeting has been registered but listed as inactive so I have taken steps to make it fully listed.

It has been a great opportunity for us to go into IOP and share through our experience the 12 steps, homegroup, sponsorship and what AA is and what it is not. The members up to this point have reported that it has been a good experience.

Presently we are waiting for a response from the administrator regarding the frequency of our visit. As of right now we are committed to holding the presentation every 3 months. The initial 1st quarter visit was scheduled to be held mid March however Rosecrance did request for us to reschedule and we are very thankful for the flexibility of our willing and able treatment participants that were able to accommodate this request.

- The Rosecrance beginners meeting is moving along well and heavily attended which they are thankful for. This meeting is held on the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 6pm at the Crystal Lake facility. All members are welcome to attend and share their experience with the first 3 steps.
- At Northwestern Behavioral in Woodstock there has been some administrative changes and it looks like the volunteer badging process is beginning to move forward again. We recently had another member cleared and he is now contributing, however there is still a need for more participation from alcoholics anonymous. Once again the meeting times are Thursday's and Sundays at 1030am and Every other Friday's at 230pm. Please see Natae or myself If you or you know of someone who is willing to help out.
- And Finally,

Recently a group from the district has be given the opportunity to carry the message into the women's sober living at New Directions in Crystal Lake. The commitment is held once a month and currently it is carried out through the group but there may be opportunities if any women are interested to join in our primary purpose. Also, it may be a great opportunity for other groups to get involved at the sober living facility rather than one
